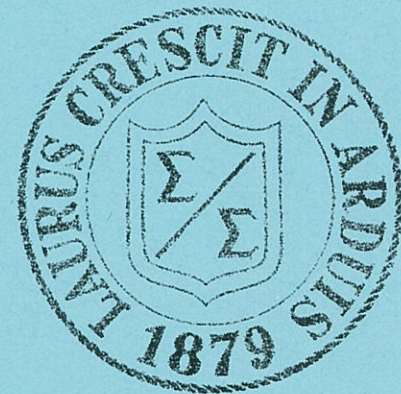

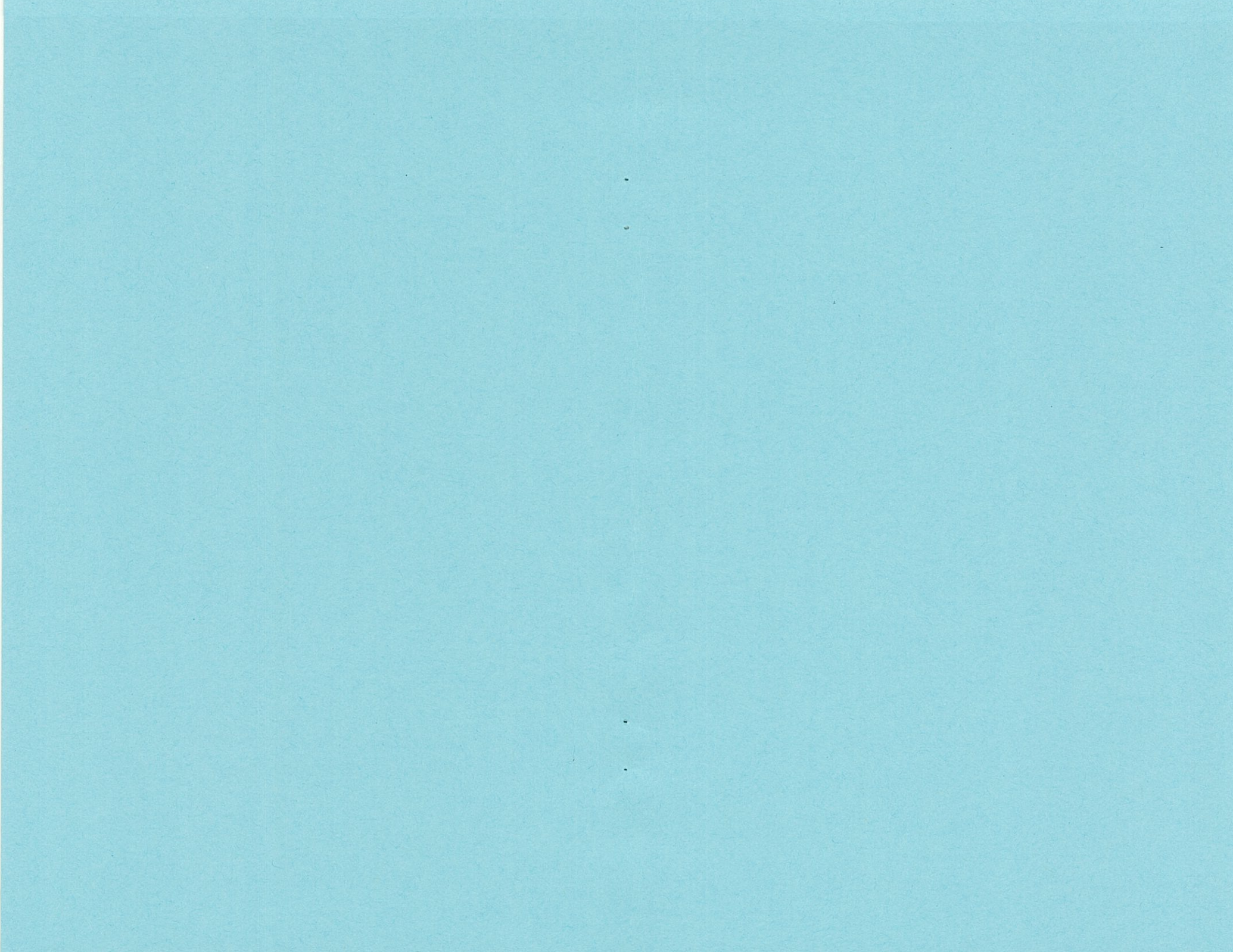

## BY-LAWS OF THE PARENT-TEACHER COUNCIL

### I. NAME

The name of this organization shall be "Parent-Teacher Council of Springside School."

### II. PURPOSE

The purpose of the organization is to promote all measures conducive to the welfare and progress of Springside School.

### III. MEMBERSHIP

The parents of all girls currently pupils of the School shall be ipso facto members of the Council. The annual dues shall be Four Dollars (\$4.00) per family. All members of the faculty of the School shall be members of the Council ex officio without the payment of dues.

### IV. EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE

The Council shall be directed by an Executive Committee composed as follows:

#### Upper-Middle School Executive Committee

President, Vice-President, Middle School Chairman, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Treasurer, Representatives of each of the Upper and Middle School classes, the Chairmen of the Standing Committees, and the Representatives of the Upper and Middle School faculties, and student representative from the Upper School.

#### Lower School Executive Committee

Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Assistant Secretary, Assistant Treasurer, Representatives of each of the Lower School classes, the Chairmen of the Standing Committees, and the Representative of the Lower School faculty.

The Headmistress, the Directors of the Upper, Middle, and Lower Schools, the President, and the Lower School Chairman shall be ex officio members of both groups and of the Committee as a whole.

### V. OFFICERS

1. The officers of the Council shall be the following: President, Vice-President, Upper-Middle School Secretary, Lower School Secretary, Treasurer, Middle School Chairman, and Lower School Chairman.

2. The Headmistress and the Directors of the Upper, Middle, and Lower Schools shall serve as officers ex officio.

3. The President, the Upper-Middle School Secretary, the Lower School Vice-Chairman, and the Lower School Secretary shall be elected for two-year terms not later than the April meeting held in even-numbered years. Not later than the April meeting held in odd-numbered years the Vice-President, Middle School Chairman, and Lower School Chairman shall be elected to serve for two years.

The Assistant Treasurer shall attend all meetings of the Parent-Teacher Council of the Lower School and shall represent the Treasurer there. She shall be elected each year and the following year she shall assume the office of Treasurer.

4. All officers' terms shall commence with the Annual Meeting following their election with the exception of the terms of the Treasurer and the Assistant Treasurer, which shall commence with the school year in September.

### VI. DUTIES OF OFFICERS

1. The President shall preside at all Upper-Middle School Executive Committee meetings and at all joint meetings. With the recommendations of the Upper-Middle School Nominating Committee, she shall appoint the Upper School Assistant Secretary and the chairmen of all committees except those that function only in the Lower School. She shall perform all other

duties usually pertaining to the office of President of a corporation or an association.

2. In the absence, or upon the resignation, of the President or of the Middle School Chairman, the Vice-President shall perform the duties of these offices.

3. In the absence, or upon the resignation, of the Lower School Chairman, the Lower School Vice-Chairman shall perform the duties of this office.

4. The Upper-Middle School Secretary shall keep the records of the Upper-Middle School Executive Committee. She shall also keep the records of all joint meetings. She shall perform all duties usually pertaining to the office of Secretary of a corporation or association.

5. The Lower School Secretary shall keep the records of the Lower School Executive Committee.

6. The Treasurer shall keep all funds of the Council and make disbursements only as directed by the Executive Committee in accordance with the purposes of the Council.

7. The Middle School Chairman shall preside at any separate Middle School meeting she may see fit to call. She shall also attend all meetings of the Upper-Middle School Executive Committee.

8. The Chairman of the Lower School shall preside over meetings of the Lower School Executive Committee. With the recommendations of the Lower School Nominating Committee she shall appoint the Assistant Lower School Secretary and the chairmen of those committees that function only in the Lower School.

### VII. REPRESENTATIVES

1. Representatives of each class shall be appointed by the Nominating Committees in April each year. Such representatives shall serve for terms of one year commencing in September.

2. Assistant representatives for each class shall be appointed each and every year by the Class Representatives.

3. Faculty Representatives shall be appointed each year by the Headmistress and the Directors of the Upper, Middle, and Lower Schools.

4. A student representative from the Upper School shall be appointed from the junior class before the Annual Meeting in May.

### VIII. COMMITTEES

Such standing or special committees shall be appointed as may be authorized or directed from time to time by the officers. There shall also be a Nominating Committee for Upper-Middle School appointed by the President and a Nominating Committee for Lower School appointed by the Lower School Chairman.

### IX. MEETINGS

1. The Upper-Middle School Executive Committee meetings and all meetings of the Executive Committee as a whole shall be held upon the call of the President.

2. Separate Middle School meetings shall be held upon the call of the Middle School Chairman.

3. Lower School Executive Committee meetings shall be held upon the call of the Lower School Chairman.

4. In each year following the election of Executive Committee members there shall be an Annual Meeting in May attended by present Executive Committee members and those just elected to office or appointed as Executive Committee members.

5. All Executive Committee meetings are open meetings.

### X. AMENDMENT

The power of amendment shall be vested in the Executive Committee. Changes may be made at any meeting of the Committee held after five days' written notice to each member of the Committee of the suggested changes.

- Are you careful not to embarrass your children in front of their friends or yours?
- Parents are under legal obligation to make certain that any car driven by their son or daughter is in safe operating condition and properly insured.
- It is the responsibility of parents to take an active interest in their children's dress since it affects behavior, attitudes and grades. Parents should see that students are appropriately dressed when they leave for school and social functions.

## LAWS IMPORTANT FOR TEENAGERS TO KNOW

- PENNSYLVANIA STATE DRIVERS LAW. "This license not valid between the hours of midnight and five a.m. unless licensee is eighteen years old, or is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian."
- Section 675.1 of the penal laws of Pennsylvania prohibits "the Purchase, Consumption, Possession or Transportation of Intoxicating Liquors or Malt or Brewed Beverages by Minors . . . It shall be unlawful for a person less than twenty-one years of age to attempt to purchase, consume, possess or to transport any alcohol liquor or malt or brewed beverages within the Commonwealth."
- The drug, device and cosmetic act of 1961 includes Act 693 which covers narcotics, drugs, and dangerous drugs. It forbids the use, importing or dispensing of narcotics and dangerous drugs. This is a Federal law.



4. Overcrowding of a car is dangerous.
5. Parents of inexperienced drivers should not allow them to carry passengers.
6. Riders have a share in the responsibility for safe driving. Dares and jeers from riders have been responsible for more than one death.
7. It is dangerous to ride with an irresponsible driver.

#### DRINKING

Section 675.1 of the penal laws of Pennsylvania prohibits "the Purchase, Consumption, Possession or Transportation of Intoxicating Liquors or Malt or Brewed Beverages by Minors . . . It shall be unlawful for a person less than twenty-one years of age to attempt to purchase, consume, possess or to transport any alcohol liquor or brewed beverages within the Commonwealth."

1. No one has the moral or legal right to serve any alcoholic beverage to other people's children. The adult who does so is legally liable for any of the serious consequences which may result.
2. Parents should ask a young person to leave if he brings alcoholic beverages to a party. No alcoholic beverages should be accessible to young guests.
3. Young people should know that it is dangerous to ride with a driver who has been drinking an alcoholic beverage. Alcohol even in small amounts slows the reflexes and hampers efficiency.

#### NARCOTICS

The use of narcotics in any form unless prescribed by a licensed physician is highly dangerous. Medicine has not been able to measure with real certainty the tremendous damage resulting from unauthorized use of drugs and narcotics.

Legally, the use, importing or dispensing of narcotics and dangerous drugs is forbidden by federal law. The drug, device and cosmetic act of 1961 includes Act 693 which covers narcotics, drugs and dangerous drugs.

#### FOR PARENTS

1. Do you always tell your children where you are? It is just as important for children to know where parents are as for parents to know where their children are.
2. Parents should be on call at their young people's parties, but not intrude on them. Trust may start here.
3. Do you set a good example for your young people all the time? Part of the time? Young people may learn more social behavior from watching their parents than from listening to them.
4. Do you accept all your children's friends whether you like them or not? Do you recognize their right to choose their own friends?
5. In spite of your love for and interest in your children, when you ask questions are you sincerely interested in their activities or are you prying? How would some of your questions sound if you were a teenager?
6. Are you willing to suggest and not force social activities on your child?
7. Do you give your children the same time and consideration you would give another adult?

"A word to the wise . . .". While drinking of alcoholic beverages, fortunately, is not a general problem in this age group, there are circumstances where it may become one. Dating within the age group is strongly recommended by school personnel. However, some eighth and ninth grade girls "date" high-school boys. They, therefore, may be confronted with the liquor problem. The dangers are numerous and apparent.

Boys and girls of this age group ordinarily can not be licensed to drive cars. However, some of their friends may be driving, and parents should be alert to the dangers involved in allowing their sons and daughters to ride with young, inexperienced drivers.

## FOR GRADES 10, 11 and 12

### DATING

1. Social activities other than school-sponsored events should be limited to weekends and holidays.
2. Dress should be appropriate to the activity, and should indicate pride in one's self and respect for others.

1. A girl and her parents should agree on a definite time for her to be expected home. A boy should be given an opportunity to meet the parents of his date, and to discuss time for expected arrival home.
2. Following a dance or party students may want to stop at a restaurant or a private home for something to eat. Since it is unsafe for young people to be on the streets late at night, it is essential that a reasonable but definite time be set for their arrival at home. It is essential that they telephone home in case of delay.
3. The Pennsylvania State Driver's Law is the final authority in deciding how late a driver who is a minor may operate a car. It states: "This license not valid between the hours of midnight and five a.m. unless licensee is eighteen years old, or is accompanied by a parent or legal guardian."

### DRIVING

1. Parental consent for driving privileges should be based on young people's proof of ability to control themselves and the car. A respect for the welfare and safety of others is essential.
2. Trained instruction is urged. Unskilled driving, as well as poor driving attitudes, can jeopardize lives and the economic welfare of an entire family.
3. Parents should be firm in their decision to take away the car privilege when it is abused. On the other hand, they should be generous in their praise of proper driving attitudes and careful handling of the car.



2. It is important that invitations, whether written or verbal, be clear as to type of function, appropriate dress, and time of beginning and ending of a party.
3. Parents should be at home when young people entertain.
4. Although young people do not want their parties to be regimented by parents, both should have a part in making plans in advance.
5. The number of guests should be limited to a group which can be accommodated easily in the home.
6. Uninvited guests should not be admitted. A written guest list will help solve the problem.
7. The host or hostess sets the tone of the party. Should a guest become unruly it may be necessary to call on a parent for assistance.
8. "Lights out" has no place in a well-ordered party.
9. Host parents should see that the party ends at the time stated in the invitation. Guest parents should call for their children at designated time, neither early nor late.

## FOR GRADES 7, 8 and 9

The in-between age (grades seven through nine) is largely an experimental period in the social development of young people. With the cooperation of all parents, this period can be a wholesome and happy one, and can aid in the development of social maturity. By setting up desirable and acceptable standards of behavior in the in-between ages, parents and young people can help to avoid later problems.

### DATING

1. "Going steady" at this age should be discouraged. Young people profit by a variety of contacts.
2. Group or double dating rather than single dating should be encouraged. Home can be a good place for informal gatherings. Parents can be of great help to young people in assisting them in arranging trips to skating rinks or to other places where they can enjoy group activity.
3. Dating within the age group is strongly recommended not only by school personnel, but by all professionals who have studied this problem.

### SCHOOL DANCES

1. Transportation should be provided by parents. This can be a shared responsibility.
2. In planning a dance for young people of this age remember it is more fun to change partners once in awhile.

### HOURS

1. A girl and her parents should agree on a definite time for her to arrive home. A boy should be given an opportunity to meet the parents of his date, and to discuss the time for their expected arrival home.
2. It is generally thought advisable for parents to transport boys and girls of this age group. Late wandering on the streets or in public places is dangerous for young people. If ninth grade boys and girls walk home from an early function, a definite time for arrival home should be set.

## WE CAN AGREE

WE CAN AGREE is a set of GUIDING PRINCIPLES to be used in the home. Its purpose is to achieve cooperation among parents and students for a safe and acceptable program of social activities for young people. It is based on parent and student surveys and has been prepared by the Parents Council of Secondary Schools, with the cooperation of the Student Auxiliaries. As Springside is a member of the Council, the Parent Teacher Council has compiled its suggestion below as a service to Springside families. Both the School and the P.T.C. heartily endorse and strongly support these guiding principles.

Presented by Parents Council of Secondary Schools of Suburban Philadelphia.

Established in 1951 in the interests of young people.

Parents are eager to have young people enrich their lives through a wholesome social life. But parents and young people alike need help in battling the gnawing suggestion: **We have to do it because everybody does it.**

Our booklet offers important guiding principles by which most teenagers and their parents are already living. Common sense has showed us that these principles are not restrictive but protective.

In the fall of 1966 both Parents Council and its Main Line branch held student conferences, attended by all their member schools, as well as by school personnel and parents, to discuss the revision of the booklet. A direct result of the conferences was a questionnaire which was distributed to the entire student body of all member schools. This new booklet is the outcome.

We believe that this booklet can best serve the purpose within the families which adopt it through mutual agreement.

### FAMILY COOPERATION

1. Sincerity and open-mindedness are important in all discussions between young people and their parents.
2. It is common courtesy to let parents know where you are and with whom, just as it is important for them to let you know where they are.
3. An allowance should be the result of mutual planning based on a discussion of financial needs as well as the ability to manage money. The majority of young people believe this planning should include the privilege of spending their money as they wish, and that none of it should be withheld as punishment.
4. Family plans should be organized so that necessary transportation of young people can be provided, and so that individual members of the family can be reached in case of emergency or change of plans.
5. Parents and young people should have a workable agreement covering casual drop-in visits by members of the opposite sex when parents are not at home.
6. It is the responsibility of parents to take an active interest in their children's appearance since it affects behavior, attitudes and grades. Parents should see that children are appropriately dressed when they leave for school and social functions.

### HOME ENTERTAINING

1. Parents should encourage young people to bring their friends home. They should welcome the opportunity to meet their sons' or daughters' companions.

## INFORMATION FOR PARENTS

### Upper and Middle Schools

#### ABSENCES

After absence because of illness a girl must report immediately to her homeroom teacher with a note from her parent stating *specific* cause of absence.

*Regular attendance is required of every student.* If an absence for reasons other than illness is necessary, parents must make arrangements with the Director well in advance. All work must be made up.

#### EARLY DISMISSALS

No student may be excused early to aid at any community function. If, because of some unusual circumstances, a girl must be excused early, she must present a note from her parent to the office, where she will be given an excuse slip. She is required to show this slip to the teachers whose classes she will not be attending and to return the dismissal slip to the office upon her departure.

#### LATENESS

A girl who is late to 8:25 roll call must report to the office and get a slip before going to class. Unnecessary lateness will be dealt with by the Director.

#### BUILDING HOURS

The building will be open from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., but the School cannot assume responsibility for girls who arrive before 8:15 or stay after 3:30, unless they have scheduled activities or appointments with teachers.

Girls who must wait for transportation should study in the library, which closes at 4:30.

The building is open on Saturday morning only through special arrangement.

#### TELEPHONE MESSAGES

To call home girls must use the pay phone booth, which is available to them only before and after school, during recess, or during lunch period.

Parents are asked to make arrangements with their daughters ahead of time. Necessary messages will be posted on Class Bulletin Boards provided they are received by noon. Girls are responsible for watching the Boards for these messages.

#### CAR PERMISSION

Girls wishing to ride to or from school activities must have the school car permission form signed by parents. These forms are obtainable in the Physical Education office.

#### ASSIGNMENTS

Students are required to keep daily assignments in uniform note books indexed by subject. These note books should be available at all times for inspection by teachers or parents.

In case of absence of a week or more, the parent should get in touch with the Director. For shorter absences, Upper School girls are responsible for obtaining homework assignments and work covered in class by telephoning a classmate. Assignments for Middle School girls may be picked up in the office after 3:30.

## FRIDAY STUDY HALLS

Although classes end at 1:00 on Fridays, the School reserves the right to schedule a student for Friday Study Hall from 1:45-3:15. Therefore, parents are asked not to make standing appointments for that time.

This Study Hall is for students who have missed class work because of illness, students who need some brief, special individual work with a teacher, or students who need supervised study in a particular subject. This is a privilege for the student. It is not the duty of teachers to provide such work for girls who fail to pay attention in class or who make no effort on their own to make up work missed.

The Friday Study Hall list is posted by Wednesday at 3:15 p.m. Girls who are required to stay for Friday Study Hall must have lunch at school.

All girls not scheduled to attend Study Hall, play on teams, etc., on Friday afternoon are urged to leave school promptly at 1:00 p.m. Girls who elect to stay at school with no specific appointments should study in the library.

## DETENTION STUDY HALL

There will be supervised detention periods on Monday after school and again on Thursday for Upper School girls, and one on Saturday morning for Middle School girls. A student who has shown marked discourtesy or lack of consideration at any time in school can be assigned automatically to one of these detention periods and will be required to attend. Should this present a serious problem, arrangements to attend the next such session will be made with the home by the Director.

Repeated necessity for such disciplinary action will be considered sufficiently grave that it may warrant suspension.

## LIBRARY RULES

Each girl will be given a library card in which books will be signed out. Fines will be imposed in accordance with public library regulations.

If a book is neither returned nor renewed after two notices from the librarian, warning is sent home that the book will be charged on the student's bill. This bill cannot be cancelled if replacement of the book has already been ordered.

*Reserve books* must not be taken from the library before the close of school and must be returned the next morning before school. If, because of illness, a girl is unable to return a reserve book herself in accordance with this regulation, she must see to it that either a member of her family or a classmate returns the book so that other students will not be deprived of it.

## LOST AND FOUND

All lost articles should be turned in to the Athletic Department, with the exception of glasses, valuables, and bookbags, which should be turned into the office. Marked articles may be reclaimed upon payment of five cents per article. A charge of ten cents will be made for unmarked articles.

## LUNCH TICKETS

\$2.00 or \$5.00 lunch tickets are preferred for purchases made at recess, for lunches bought on Fridays and during exam weeks, and for supplements for those who bring their lunches from home.

Lost lunch tickets cannot be replaced.



## SUPPLIES

Supplies may be purchased at the school store before school on Mondays through Fridays. Text books are charged on the school bill, but all other purchases must be paid for in cash.

## SCHOOL UNIFORM

The school uniform must be worn daily by Upper and Middle School girls. The uniform consists of the following:

Plaid Wraparound Skirt (to be worn from the second day of school until Thanksgiving and on return from Spring vacation).

Plaid Kilt (to be worn from Thanksgiving to Spring vacation).  
(*Skirts and kilts are to be no shorter than three inches above the knee, measured when the student is kneeling.*)

## Lower School

### ABSENCES

Prompt and regular attendance is required of every student. Springside does not give permission to miss school for outside activities or appointments except for medical or dental emergencies.

A child returning after an illness should bring a note from home stating the cause of absence, unless the parent has been in contact with the school by telephone.

### Homework for Absentees

In case of absence, teachers of grades 2, 3, and 4 will have assignments and textbooks in the school office at dismissal time of the *second* day of absence. Parents are asked please to pick these up promptly. In the case of a prolonged absence, further assignments will be mailed home or given over the telephone on request.

### BUILDING HOURS

No girl should come to school before 8:15 unless it is absolutely necessary. Please phone the school to make arrangements if earlier arrival is unavoidable.

It is important that girls be called for promptly unless the office has been notified in advance. We cannot provide chaperonage after 4 p.m.

A note or phone call is required if a girl's after-school plans are changed from the usual. Social engagements should be made at home, not at school.

### CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

No uniform is required at Lower School, but simplicity of dress is expected. All girls in grades 1-4 should wear blouses and skirts or jumpers with shorts underneath on gym days.

#### For Kindergarten:

Crib blanket or small bath rug, marked on one side with large letters (No large blankets, please.)

Small blanket (1st and 2nd grades only)

Sneakers (Must be kept at school)

All clothing and equipment should be marked with the girl's name.

### BIRTHDAY PARTIES

It seems important to re-emphasize at intervals the following policy adopted several years ago by the Parent Teacher Council concerning out-of-school parties:

"It is hoped that invitations to parties will be extended either to less than half of a class section or to the entire section. If the majority are invited, those left out can be greatly hurt."

Some girls elect to have a simple birthday celebration at school. Usually the parent provides paper plates and napkins and a cake or cupcakes to be enjoyed at recess or after lunch by her daughter's section. Arrangements should be made in advance with the homeroom teacher.
